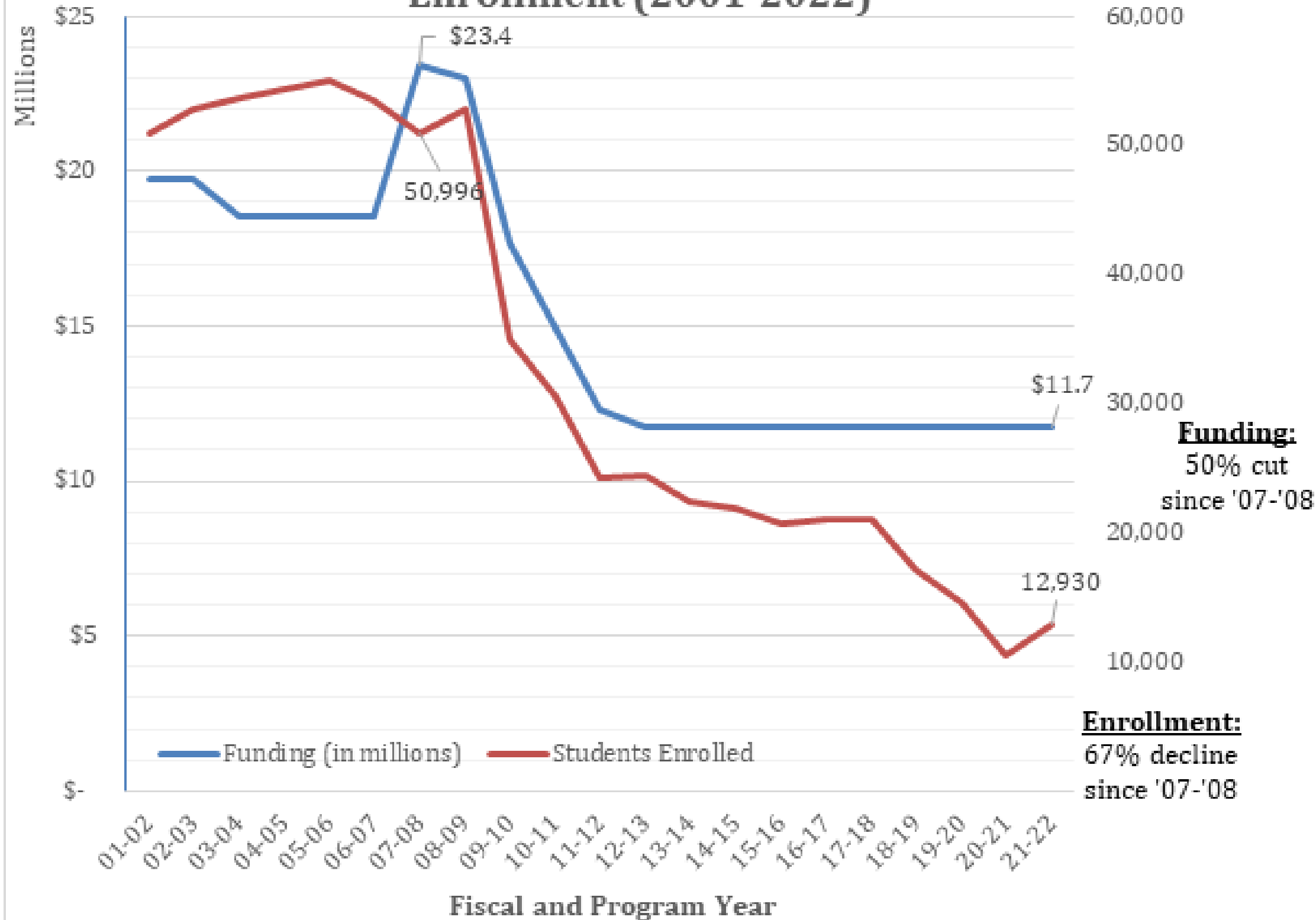

Adult & Family Literacy Education Funding and Enrollment (2001-2022)



INCREASE ADULT EDUCATION FUNDING

- 646,612 working age adults in PA do not have high school diplomas.
- 387,549 working age adults do not speak English well or at all.
- More than 64,000 students dropped out of high school in the last five year.

2020 PIAAC DATA: State and County Indicators of Adult Literacy and Numeracy for the 9,435,000 PA residents ages 16-74

- 18% of Pennsylvanians ages 16-74 are at or below PIAAC proficiency level 1 in literacy – considered at risk for difficulties using or comprehending print material.
- 29% of Pennsylvanians ages 16-74 are at or below PIAAC proficiency level 1 in numeracy – considered at risk for difficulties with numeracy.
